USE.

INSPECTION.



Check condition of rubber feet. Ensure they are fitted, secure, clean and not worn.



Inspect condition of spun ends on rungs. Check for splits / cracks. Check for dents in rungs and stiles.



Check each rung to ensure there is no rotation. Firmly grasp and attempt to turn each on in turn.



Check that fasteners are all present and secure, look for loose rivets.



Ensure that all bolts and wing nuts are fitted.



Tuck in stowage straps on base section.



Fully engage spigots.



Ensure that the head of the retaining bolt is proud of the stile to allow the spigots to engage easily.



Do up the the wing nuts and check that the shoulder on the head of the bolt sits inside the stile do not overtighten !



The ladder **must** be positioned at approximately 75 degrees. (1 measure out for every 4 measures up)



When ascending or descending always firmly grasp the stiles with both hands.

Always observe safety precautions !

People are killed and seriously injured in accidents involving ladders. Do not rest a ladder on an unstable surface, on loose ground or slopes. Always have at least 1.1 Metres of ladder above any landing place. Avoid overreaching - keep the body within the stiles. Avoid using in close proximity to electrical hazards. Where possible secure the ladder at the top and base. Never have more than one person on a ladder at a time.
